



Script Frenzy's YWP Page-Count-Goal Calculator

Unlike Script Frenzy's main website, which requires that you write a 100-page script in April, Script Frenzy's Young Writers Program website allows you to set your own challenging, yet attainable, personal page-count goal.

Below is a chart with minimum and maximum page-count goals broken down by grade level. This chart is designed to help you get an idea of what kind of goal to set for yourself, but you don't have to go by what it says. If you're in the 5th grade and you want to shoot for 100 pages, go for it! If you're in the 10th grade and you want to try for 20 pages, there's nothing wrong with that. We will say that the more challenging the goal you set for yourself, the more frenzied fun you're going to have this April (not to mention how much more awesome you'll feel once Script Frenzy is over).
